**COOPERATIVE EDUCATION
SAFETY AGREEMENT**
(Between 16-18 years of age)

This is to certify that _____, a student-learner, is enrolled in a Cooperative Education training program conducted by Miami-Dade County Public School System. This student-learner is employed under a written agreement in compliance with the Child Labor provisions of the Fair Labor Standard Act, Child Labor Bulletin No. 101, which provides:

That the student-learner enrolled in this program will be under the supervision of the cooperative education teacher who is responsible to determine whether or not a specific occupation is hazardous. If the occupation is deemed hazardous, the cooperative education teacher must complete and attach the Child Labor Law Hazardous Occupation, Student Learner Exemption Agreement, FM-5557 (09-96).

That safety instruction shall be given to the student-learner by the cooperative education teacher and correlated by the employer with on-the-job training.

That signed copies of the written agreement shall be kept on file by both the cooperative education teacher and the employer.

As of the date below, the student-learner named above has been instructed in safety measures and has satisfactorily passed a general safety test.

STUDENT-LEARNER AGREEMENT

Having the knowledge and understanding of general safety procedures necessary for me to be a safe student-learner, I promise to obey all safety practices and regulations at all times. Furthermore, I will not attempt to perform any task or operate any equipment until qualified and authorized.

COOPERATIVE EDUCATION SAFETY TEST GUIDELINES

Written safety examinations shall be administered to all cooperative education student student-learners seeking on-the-job training in accordance with the provisions set forth in the Child Labor Bulletin No. 101. The test shall consist of general safety precautions applicable to occupations selected by student/cooperative education teacher.

Written examinations may be administered by either the cooperative education education teacher and/or by a certified subject area vocational teacher.

The cooperative education teacher will score all written safety tests administered in his/her area and will maintain them on file in the confidential individual student-learner file folder. A score of 90-100% is required for a passing grade.

Student-learners with passing scores of 90% but less than 100% will be required to receive supplemental instruction on those test items incorrectly answered. It will be the responsibility of the cooperative education teacher to provide for this instruction, ascertain the student-learner's understanding and to make notation of the completion on the student's test paper. All notations of this nature should be dated and signed by both cooperative education teacher and the student-learner.

Student-learners scoring 89% or less will be permitted one (1) retest, per occupation, to qualify for placement consideration.

It is recommended that student-learners be provided applicable safety instructional material for self-study prior to the examination.

When advisable, evaluation of student-learners may be performance-based. Arrangements are to be made by the cooperative education teacher processing the applicant. Performance-based safety tests will be administered and scored by a certified subject area vocational teacher. The final grade will be marked as either "Satisfactory" or "Unsatisfactory".

Authorized persons administering safety tests will initiate and sign the safety agreement agreement. Completed copies of the Safety Agreement will be maintained in the confidential student-learner file folder.
